



The 300 Club

The 300 Club is a private quarterly lottery and is open to all members, family, friends and work colleagues and costs just £25 per annum per ticket.

The 300 Club is simplicity in itself to join and every participant gets the chance to win in the quarterly draws. Members of the 300 Club must be over 16 years old to join and pay by standing order (cheques are accepted).

All you need to do is decide **HOW MANY NUMBERS YOU WANT**, complete your details and the standing order form below and hand it back to a 300 Club committee member or Shire Horse Society office to get you entered.

You will receive a card confirming your numbers and the winning numbers will be posted on the website after each draw. The numbers can only win once a year.

Although we are calling it the 300 Club, we will begin running the draw as soon as we have 50 members, but we will not exceed the maximum of 300 members.

The quarterly prize money is 50% of the money from the sale in each quarter, therefore the more people that join, the bigger the prize! Therefore, if all 300 tickets are sold, you could win just under £1,000!

The rules are simple: The club will pay out depending upon the number of entrants with the minimum prize of £25.00 per drawer.

The draw for the prize winner will take place on each quarter day, or closest working day to the relevant quarter day. For the avoidance of doubt, the quarter days are: 25th March, 25th June, 25th September and 25th December.

The 300 Club Rules

1. The name of the draw is the 300 Club ("the Lottery") regardless of the number of shares.
2. The purpose of the Lottery is to raise funds for the sole benefit of The Meddings Foundation ("the Club").
3. The Lottery will be administered by the SHS office ("the Promoter"), appointed by the Executive Committee.
4. The Lottery shall run continuously from 1st January 2018 and the first draw shall be 25th March 2018.
5. The Lottery will be open to anybody aged 16 or over. A purchaser of a share becomes a participant in the lottery. Participants are entitled to hold any number of shares.
6. The number of shares in the Lottery shall be limited to a maximum of 300 and each share shall be allocated a unique number. Membership tickets will be issued.
7. The subscription for each share is £25 per annum payable in advance. Participants may also pay annually **in advance** by Standing Order or cheque (made payable to The Meddings Foundation).
8. Numbers will be allocated in sequence when applications are received. No preference for a particular number will be granted.
9. There shall be a draw made each quarter using the automatic random number generator on www.random.org or by other such means as the Promoter deems appropriate.
10. The Promoter will not pay a prize to any Participant other than the purchaser of a winning share.
11. No Lottery participant will be included in the draw if the subscription has not been received. It is the responsibility of each Participant to make sure they have paid their subscription. The Promoter reserves the right to reallocate any number where payment has not been received.
12. Participants can cancel their entry in the Lottery at any time by giving one month's written notice to the Promoter. Any decision by the Club to end the lottery will also be by one month's notice to all Participants.
13. Under no circumstances can subscriptions be refunded.
14. The Promoter will determine any dispute. An appeal may be made to the Executive Committee whose decision shall be final.
15. The Lottery is intended to be a Small Society Lottery under the provisions of the Gambling Act 2005 Section 19.
16. The Executive Committee may amend or vary the rules of the lottery at any time. The rules of the Lottery will be available via the SHS website. Changes will be notified to Participants via the Society website.
